



1. Introduction

- 1.1. This Cookie Policy explains how Sarasin Asset Management Limited ("**SAM**") uses cookies on its website. This Cookie Policy applies to everyone who visits its website, please read it carefully.
- 1.2. www.sarasinassetmanagement.com is a site operated by Sarasin & Partners LLP ("**S&P**") on behalf of SAM. SAM is registered in England and Wales with registration number 163584 and has registered offices at Juxon House, 100 St. Paul's Churchyard, London EC4M 8BU.
- 1.3. SAM is authorised and regulated by the U.K. Financial Conduct Authority and registered with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.

2. What is a Cookie?

- 2.1. Your internet browser has a feature called "**Cookies**" which store small amounts of data on your computer about your visit to a website and distinguishes you from other users of the website. They are widely used in order to make websites work more efficiently and to provide website owners with information about how the website is used. Cookies improve your browsing experience by:
 - (a) remembering settings so you do not have to keep re-entering them whenever you visit a new page;
 - (b) remembering information you have given (e.g. country of residence) so you do not have to keep re-entering it; and
 - (c) measuring how you use the website so SAM can make sure it meets your needs.
- 2.2. There are 3 types of cookies:
 - (a) Strictly Necessary Cookies – these enable users to browse a website and allow the features of the website to work correctly such as navigating between pages of a website;
 - (b) Performance Cookies – these enable website owners to collect information on how visitors use the website such as which are the most popular pages of a website; and
 - (c) Targeting Cookies – these are cookies that form part of technology which is provided or powered by a third party.

3. How SAM Uses Cookies

- 3.1. SAM does not collect any personal information about you from browsing SAM's website. Cookies are used so that the website recognises you have accepted the disclaimer (which is a regulatory requirement) so it will not appear each time you navigate to a new page of the website. Cookies are also used to gather anonymous usage of pages via Google Analytics.
- 3.2. Google Analytics stores information about what pages you visit, how long you are on the website, how you got here and what you click on. SAM does not collect or store your personal information (e.g. your name or address) so this information cannot be used to identify who you are. SAM does not allow Google to use or share our analytic data. Google's privacy policy is available at www.google.com/privacy-policy.html.
